

DAILY SIGHTSEEING IN CAIRO

PYRAMIDS & SPHINX

Visit the Giza plateau where the great Pyramids loom high at the edge of the desert. In front of these structures men stands in awe. Visit the enigmatic Sphinx. This creature with a human head and a lion's body defies time. End your visit at a papyrus institute to discover the process of manufacturing this ancient paper. NB: The visit will cover one Pyramid only, either the 2nd or 3rd.

SAKKARA & MEMPHIS

Memphis the first capital of Egypt, once one of the most famous cities of the ancient world, has disappeared except for the ruins of

some temples, the statues of Ramses II and an alabaster Sphinx. A few miles away is the necropolis of Sakkara; visit the step Pyramid of Zoser, the first structure ever built, visit a mastaba as an example of old kingdom tombs and end with a visit to one of the Pyramids whose interior walls are inscribed with the Pyramid texts.

On the way back passing by the Hierakonpolis village, a stop at one of the rag schools to see its process is an experience.

EGYPTIAN MUSEUM



To set the historical scene of Egypt, visit the Egyptian Museum which houses the finest, largest and most breathtaking collection of ancient Egyptian treasures in the world. Your guide will describe and comment on the master pieces of Pharaonic civilization, including the Tut Ankh Amon collection. This Museum is unique and a guided visit is not to be missed.

OLD CAIRO

Drive through the ancient quarters of old Cairo to visit the Hanging Church, the St. Barbara Church and the Abu Serga Church, where according to belief, the Virgin Mary, Joseph and the Child rested in its crypt upon their arrival in Egypt.



Continue to the 13th century Ben Ezra synagogue, then go to Sacker's Citadel. Visit the Citadel walls, see the Mohamed Ali Mosque, a fine example of Ottoman architecture.
